Reading: EEN: Heros and History, p. 7
beginning with Bloody Sunday

Activity: EEN Quiz (2 pages)

The readings prompted discussion about various types of systemic racism in the United States, in the past as well as currently. We discussed the difficulty some citizens have in procuring legal identification and compared American systems with those in some Asian countries.

Students completed the quiz, and we began reading questions and answers before the break. Some of the questions/answers prompted good discussion from students.

After the break, we completed review of the quiz, and continued conversation. Students volunteered information about watching American television (with subtitles) in their native countries.
