

How to play Taboo: Cut the words apart. Fold each in half so no one can read them. Give each person a set number (three?) folded papers. The first player opens a paper and tries to get the others to say the word in one minute or less. The first player cannot say the word but they can define it, describe it or act it out. If the first player is successful, he or she is awarded one marker (a Bingo stone). After the first player, go around the table in turns until all players have used all their words. The person with the most markers is the winner.
